

The number of students whom have met or exceeded the Winter NWEA *Reading* assessment, however by gender, SPed, GE, ESL



56% of students met or exceeded their Winter growth target goal on the NWEA *Math* assessment, we are on a upward trend to meet the goal in the Spring for K-8.






